

# CALL FOR PROPOSALS

## **Consultant Engineers for the Implementation of MIG and Electrification Projects for the Period of 2018/2019 and 2019/2020**

Tenders are hereby invited in terms of Section 110 of the Local Government: Municipal Finance Management Act, 56 of 2003 read with the Jozini Supply Chain Management Policy to submit proposals for the implementation of the MIG project for the period of the 2018/2019 and 2019/2020 financial years. Compulsory Municipal Bid Documents (MBD forms) that need to form part of your proposal can be requested from the Municipal SCM Unit. Consultants are required to indicate the percentage fee that will be charged to render project management in terms of the Engineering Council of South Africa (ECSA) rates.

The scope of the work will include, but not be limited to, completion of project including site assessment, preliminary design, survey, detailed design, tender document preparation, supervision, project management, close-out report and handover of project.

**Sealed tenders, clearly endorsed "Tender No: JMC001/09/17: Consultant Engineers for the Implementation of MIG Projects" or "Tender No: JMC001/09/17: Consultant Engineers for the Implementation of Electrification Projects", must be placed in the Municipality's tender box located in the Circle Street, Bottom Town, Jozini, before 12:00 on 3 November 2017.**

**NB:** Proposals must be accompanied by MBD forms obtainable from Jozini Municipality's website or can be e-mailed on request.

**Tender requirements:** • Valid Tax Clearance Certificate/Pin • Proof of payment of municipal rates • Original or certified copy of B-BBEE to claim preferential points • Proof of registration with relevant bodies • Percentage % to be charged including disbursements • Completed MBD forms (obtainable from Jozini website).

The tender will be adjudicated according to the functionality as follows:

List of contactable references of tenderer's performance on previous projects undertaken	20
CVs of key personnel to be allocated for the project	20
Proof of registration with relevant bodies	10
Project plan to ensure successful implementation of the MIG project	10
Skills transfer plan	10
<b>Total points</b>	<b>100</b>

The minimum points that must be scored by a tenderer is 70 points and failure will disqualify the tenderer from the tendering appointment. Only tenderers that pass the functionality will be evaluated further for preferential points calculation.
